### **By train**



This is the easiest and fastest way to visit us. We are situated 300 metres from the train station "St-Cyr-en-Val - La Source", on the TER (Regional Express Train) line Orleans-Vierzon and Orleans-Bourges.

From Paris Austerlitz: 1 h and 15 min on average with changing in Orleans - Les Aubrais or Orleans main station.

From Orleans - Les Aubrais or Orleans main station: 7 or 15 minutes, respectively.

After arriving at the train station of St-Cyr-en-Val – La Source, coming from Paris or Orleans: go down the street in front of the station, pass below the railway bridge and take the first street on the right (Avenue Buffon). The FOOTWAYS building is at 200 metres distance on the left, next to Cristalline bottling plant.

### **By bus**



The SEMTAO bus line No. 20 (Orleans main station <-> Saint Cyr en Val - Petite Mérie) allows you to reach us in 30 minutes from Orleans main station (you can directly walk over from the railway station to the bus station within the same building). Get off at the bus stop "Buffon Rodin", walk a few metres to Avenue Buffon and turn right. FOOTWAYS is located 150 m from the bus stop.

## By bicycle



You can reach us easily by bicycle from Orleans centre via cycle path. For this, follow the cycle path from the bridge René Thinat straight on to the large roundabout at Parc Floral. After passing the BRGM (the French Geological Survey), turn left to Avenue Buffon. Our site is located at the end of the street, between OCP and Cristalline, on the right.

## By car
